

# Petal Ring Decoration



## You will need:

- \* An empty Dorset Cereal packet
- \* Old cards
- \* Glue (liquid or stick)
- \* Scissors
- \* String or ribbon to hang
- \* Little buttons, glitter or sequins



1 Cut a circle about 8-9cm in diameter from the packaging (eg trace around a tin). Cut a smaller circle out of the middle to make a doughnut shape.

2 Using the cut-outs on the Dorset Cereal pack, trace six large petals onto the back of a greeting card. Use the shape marked **L** on the right.



3 Dab glue onto the bottom back half of the large petals and stick them around the circle.



**4** Now trace and cut six medium and six small petals. Glue these petals closer to the centre of the ring as shown.



**5** Next trace six more large petals, same size as the first ones.



**6** Glue these petals on the back of the ring, in between the other large petals.



**7** Attach a short length of string or ribbon to the back.



*How about making a hanging entirely out of Dorset cereal packaging? For white petals, use the reverse side of the card. Nice, eh?*



**8** Add embellishments like small buttons, sequins or glitter.
